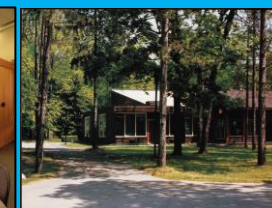

\$950 + HST (13%) if deposit is made **after** February 1, 2018

There are **only 40 spots available** at the camp. To hold a spot we ask for a non-refundable \$250 deposit by February 1, 2018. If received by February 1<sup>st</sup>, you are guaranteed a spot, and a savings of \$55!

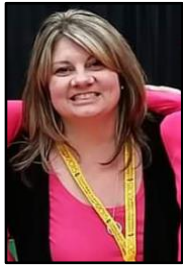
