Please take note that **Georgian College does not allow any outside food to be brought into the competition facility**. To accommodate our baton twirlers and spectators during the competition, the restaurant located in the Athletic Centre will be open on Saturday from 11 am - 5 pm and on Sunday from 11 am - 2 pm. They are suggesting that after the restaurant closes, if water or drinks are needed there are appropriate vending machines to service the public.

Since the facility rental contract specifically says 'no food', coolers will not be permitted entry. Please respect this arrangement. The host club suggests that any snacks or beverages for personal consumption should be brought in your purse or baton bag.

On Saturday, there is no scheduled break for lunch, but the judges, coaches and athletes should be able to find time for their lunch during the SoloDance and Pre-Event portion of the competition (scheduled between 11:30 and 12:30). There is a short scheduled supper break at 5:30 pm. We suggest you order from the restaurant so that you have your food ready when the break happens.
