DIRECTIVE: Compulsory/Short Program Suit for 2010 Competition Season

For the 2010 competition season, the Compulsory Suit dress code requirements will remain relaxed.

In April/2009 the <u>new 'Fever' Compulsory Suit</u> [1] was introduced, and made its international debut at the 2009 International Cup. At the November/2009 Fall Board Meeting, the Board passed a motion mandating the use of the 'Fever' suit, *effective September 2010*.

The practical impact of these decisions is:

- Freestyle members of the Canadian Contingent to the 2010 World Championships must wear the 'Fever' suit.
- Level A athletes, at Open, Provincial or National competitions *must* wear the 'Fever' suit beginning <u>September</u> <u>2010</u>. Until then, they may wear the 'Fever' Suit, the 'Simply Best' Suit or a plain black leotard.
- Level B & C athletes, at Open, Provincial or National competitions may wear *either* the 'Fever' Suit *or* a plain black leotard beginning <u>September 2010</u>. Until then, they may wear the 'Fever' Suit, the 'Simply Best' Suit or a plain black leotard.
