	JUDGES – ONLINE (BUT NOT LIVE)	JUDGES – LIVE ONLINE	JUDGES – IN-PERSON
ATHLETES – VIDEO SUBMISSION	<p>VIDEO REVIEWS Athletes film and submit videos that are assigned to judges for judging at their “leisure” (within a specified time frame) similar to the online badge testing program. Athletes receive critique sheet with comments, but no grade, no ribbons.</p>	<p>VIDEO VIRTUAL COMPETITION Athletes film and submit videos that are categorized into divisions. Judge(s) join online to watch and judge the video submissions in real time (i.e. the Zoom host controls the playback of the video and moves it along at the pace of a regular competition) Critique sheets/masters emailed/uploaded for tabulation. Athletes receive critique sheet with comments, but no grade, no ribbons.</p>	
ATHLETES – LIVE ONLINE		<p>COMPLETELY VIRTUAL COMPETITION Athletes twirl at home/individual chosen locations at a specified time (follow a set system and log into Zoom when it is your set). Need good internet and video capabilities “on location” Critique sheets/masters emailed/uploaded in real time to tabulation. Arrange for announcements of awards where everyone who participated can join in on a Zoom conference. Athletes receive critique sheet with comments, a grade, and ribbon.</p>	
ATHLETES – IN-PERSON		<p>VIRTUALLY JUDGED COMPETITION Need a facility with little or no capacity/physical distancing restrictions OR the ability to schedule your event such that the capacity restrictions can be met. Need good internet and video capabilities! Run this as close as possible to a “regular competition”, but the judges aren’t in the facility (inability or not willing to travel). Athletes receive critique sheet with comments, a grade and ribbon.</p>	<p>REGULAR COMPETITION Need a facility with little or no capacity/physical distancing restrictions OR the ability to schedule divisions such that the capacity restrictions can be met. Need ability and willingness of judges to travel (not all provinces have local judges available).</p>

***Note – All pre-competitive disciplines can be offered at these competitions provided you are following your provincial health guidelines and provincial return to sport stages/phases/restrictions (i.e. you cannot offer pre-competitive group if your province is not in that phase of return to sport).**
