CBTF SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS JUNE 15th ANNUALLY

Annually the Canadian Baton Twirling Federation recognizes and awards a scholarship to a CBTF athlete who will be attending a post-secondary institution as a full-time student enrolled in a graduate or undergraduate (diploma or degree) program in the coming September.

This award is one-time only and is nonrenewable.

The recipient will be announced during an Awards Ceremony at the Canadian Championships.

What is a scholarship? A scholarship is a way of recognizing and financially aiding students who have achieved academic and personal excellence.

Criteria: The CBTF Scholarship is based on four criteria:

1. The applicant must be an active, full-time, competitive CBTF baton twirler and accepted into a post-secondary institution as of September (current year).
2. The applicant must be a Member in Good Standing with the CBTF. Any significant athlete/parent outstanding bills is unacceptable.
3. The applicant must show intent to remain involved with the sport as an athlete, coach, judge, volunteer, etc.
4. The applicant must highlight his or her academic performance and personal excellence.

Note: Although community service is not a requirement, some involvement may be a deciding factor between two athletes of comparable academic standing.

How do I apply?

1. Complete the application & email the form to athletesrep@cbtf.ca
2. Application questions must be completed in full. In the case of a printed form, please use a separate sheet if additional space is required.
3. Declaration information must be completed and included with the application form.
4. Please include a link to your institution's webpage that describes the program in which you will be enrolled.
5. Please include your post-secondary institution's letter of acceptance.

RECEIPT OF APPLICATION DEADLINE IS JUNE 15th annually

TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECEIPT

After the following terms are met, the CBTF Treasurer shall release the scholarship funding to the award recipient:

1. The athlete must provide a confirmation of enrollment at the post-secondary institution to the 1st Vice-President; and
2. The athlete must renew his or her CBTF membership. Renewal shall be confirmed by the CBTF Membership Registrar to the 1st Vice-President.
